

Click on PowerTeacher Pro to get into gradebook.




Pay attention to the class that is in the box at the top. You'll need to remember which one it was later. Start with a S1 class.

First

Click on "Settings" then "Traditional Grade Calculations"



Click on the pencil icon under actions for the row labeled F1.




Click the small plus twice to add two more lines.

Then use the drop down boxes to make all three types = term weighting


The attributes should be the two quarters (Q1/Q2 or Q3/Q4) and the exam (E1)

Make the weight either 45/45/10 or 40/40/20. Usually state or federally tested subjects use 20% for the exam.



Click Save


Click on the pencil icon under actions for the row labeled Q1 or Q3.



Make the type = category weighting Make the attribute = classwork The weight stays = 1

Repeat this step for Q2 or Q4 and the E1. So two more times.

You should no longer have the below message under the class.




Click on the gear in the top right and click "copy traditional grade calculations"
